Kardelen Mercy Teams, a CMC ministry partner located in Turkey, is a Christ-centered ministry with the goal of helping disabled children and their families encounter the love and grace of Jesus Christ through their medical ministry. In Turkey, special needs children and their families are often shunned by the community. Qualified physical and occupational therapists visit the homes of disabled children to provide physical therapy as well as adaptive equipment, in addition to sharing hope and the gospel message with these families. Funds will be used for wheelchairs, walkers, prosthetic and orthotic equipment, physiotherapy and medicine.

Offering Goal: \$45,980



Holland Free Health Clinic, a CMC ministry partner located in our beautiful city, expresses the healing ministry of Jesus Christ by facilitating access to health care for those in need. Funds will be used to support HFHC's ministry to the underserved diabetic population in Holland through their foot clinic, diabetic education, dental & vision services, medication, counseling and support groups. Each of these services provide an opportunity to share the gospel message of Jesus, especially the "Pamper & Prayer" foot clinic.

The Biblical Seminary of Colombia, a non-denominational Bible college known as FUSBC in Colombia, is home to RCA missionaries Andrew and Amy Fields. FUSBC is committed to providing solid Bible knowledge, sound doctrinal academia, holistic formation of church leaders and research relevant to their context. Over the past 35 years, 663 students have graduated from FUSBC and are now pastoring hundreds of churches in major cities of Colombia, contributing to the growth of the Christian church in Colombia. Funds will be used to provide roof repair to three buildings on the seminary campus.

Offering Goal: \$13,800



South Shore Youth Impact is a ministry to children, teens, women and families in Holland. They are located on 20th Street, in the heart of our CMC neighborhood. Many of their volunteers come from My Father's House and Real Life Fellowship. The Summer Fun 4 Kids, a ten-week program including sports, crafts and Bible study, is in need of playground and sports equipment. The building that houses their clothing ministry is in need of some small repairs.

Offering Goal: \$6,000



Lakeshore Habitat for Humanity seeks to put God's love into action by bringing people together to build homes, communities and hope. As our city has become a popular place to live, affordable housing has become difficult to find. In response to this need, Lakeshore Habitat will be building five affordable homes on 40th Street, east of Lincoln Ave. CMC will provide part of the funds needed for the first home.

Offering Goal: \$25,000



Quality and Affordable Housing/Mosaic Christian Community is a ministry located in Benton Harbor and led by David Kool. They seek to share Christ's love in the Northwest Hillside neighborhood of Benton Harbor through housing renovation. Mosaic hopes to purchase, renovate and resell up to ten homes in the neighborhood, and CMC will provide part of the funds for the third of these homes.

Offering Goal: \$25,000

Any amounts collected in excess of our goal will be used for the CMC Disaster Relief Fund.
